The first plane built in Wichita rolled out of production in 1917, when Clyde Cessna assembled his Comet. Wichita's first commercial aircraft, the Swallow, came from the E.M. Events over the past decade have shown that the threat of terrorism against the United States is an ever-present danger. This situation still exists, Mr. Chairman, and as I will discuss, there are long-standing problems that affect screener performance.
