Parties for the East Coast could go from Jacksonville to New Smyrna by steamer or

sailboat, then up or down the inside, or outside, waters to destination on sailboats; or could take steamer up the St. Johns to Sanford, or Enterprise, and stage or wagon to New Smyrna or Titusville, then small sailboat up or down the coast.
